**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-03**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REPEALING EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 2020-01**

WHEREAS, the City of Beresford adopted emergency ordinance # 2020-01 on March 26, 2020, to address a public health crisis by implementing certain measures which were deemed necessary to slow the community spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, the City of Beresford, pursuant to its home rule charter, has authority to repeal emergency ordinances such as emergency ordinance 2020-01 adopted on March 26, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2020, governor Kristi Noem signed Executive Order 2020-20 to put into effect a “Back to Normal” plan outlining guidance for individuals, employers, schools, health care providers and local governments in response to the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Beresford encourages its citizens, businesses, and organizations to engage in and encourage practices that follow the guidance provided by the state of South Dakota and the CDC which will help to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by the City Council for the City of Beresford as follows:

1. That Beresford City Ordinance # 2020-01, an Emergency Ordinance to Address a Public Health Crisis by Implementing Certain Measures Which Have Been Deemed Necessary to Slow the Community Spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) is hereby repealed. This repeal shall be effective immediately upon passage by the Beresford City Council.
