Special Meeting

Tuesday, September 29, 2020 5:30 P.M.

The Beresford City Council met in special session in City Council Chambers on September 29, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

Members Present: Mayor Nathan Anderson presiding, Troy Boone, Troy Doeden, Art Schott, Teresa Sveeggen and Michael Tiedeman.

Members Absent: Gerald Dahlin

Also Present: Elaine Johnson, Finance Officer; and Jerry Zeimetz, City Administrator.

Adopt Agenda: Doeden made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Boone and all present Council members voted aye; motion carried.

New Business:

Consider first reading Ordinance #2020-07 An Ordinance Amending Ordinance #2020-06 Fiscal Year 2021 Appropriations: City Administrator Zeimetz reviewed Ordinance #2020-07 and explained the property tax levy amount adjustment. The first reading of Ordinance 2020-06 - Fiscal Year 2021 Appropriations was held and placed on file at City Hall.

Approve hiring Municipal Liquor Store Manager: The Finance & Utilities Committee consisting of Sveeggen, Tiedeman and Doeden along with Mayor Anderson, City Administrator Zeimetz and Finance Officer Johnson interviewed 5 candidates for the Municipal Liquor Store Manager. The committee made their recommendation. Doeden made the motion, seconded by Tiedeman to approve hiring Maverick Ivarsen at \$16.00/hr. All present Council Members voted aye, motion carried. It was noted that Ivarsen will not qualify for a raise on January 1, 2021 but rather a 6-month review and possible wage increase will be conducted in April 2021.
