Beresford also has an exceptional K-12 educational system. Beresford's fabulous teachers provide students with the cutting-edge technology that will take them into the future.

Beresford is poised for growth with 250 acres in our two economic development parks. We are aggressively seeking new businesses and quality jobs for our residents. All of our utilities are city-owned, and with our telephone, cable and telecommunication system in place, we have ample fiber optics available to handle any business requirements. This will give our present business owners and all new businesses the technology that they may require now and in the future. We have our own electrical substation with four professional linemen who keep the power flowing within the city. ## Development

The Beresford Economic Development Corporation has been working on improving the City of Beresford for many years. The corporation works with existing businesses looking to expand and with new businesses looking to relocate.

The Development Corporation has two development parks with over 240 acres of land available. The Northwest Development Park, consisting of 90 acres, is located adjacent to I-29 and just off SD Hwy 46. Build-ready lots from one-half acre and larger. The second industrial park is located at the northeast corner of the Beresford city limits and consists of 150 acres.

The Beresford Economic Development Corporation, in cooperation with the Beresford Housing Redevelopment Commission, will complete the Ash Creek Housing Development in 2015 which includes 31 housing lots — 18 of those for twin homes and 13 for single-family homes. The housing development, on the south side of Bridges Golf Course, has build-ready lots ranging from \$32,500 to \$69,900.

## Public Library

The Beresford Public Library was established in 1923 by a local study club. In 1924, the city took over operations of the library, deeming it to be a public necessity. The library continues to provide citizens with a wide variety of resources for enlightenment and enjoyment as well as a center for learning and creativity.

In 1992, the library board, city and community members sponsored a fund drive to remodel and relocate the library. The city now boasts a beautiful library over 9,000 square feet with two community rooms that are heavily used.

In the last 10 years, the library has received three national award recognitions. In 2010, the library was recognized in the top-10 in its category in the Hennen's American Public Library Rankings. In 2013 and 2014, the Beresford Public Library was recognized in the Library Journal as one of America's Star Libraries. All of the rankings are established based on a combination of reporting to the South Dakota State Library and Institute of Museum and Library Services. One thing the rankings do measure very clearly is how effectively and efficiently high-quality services are delivered to a community for the dollars spent per capita.

The library is a 21st century library with a Wi-Fi hotspot and is a social gathering hub for both children and adults. Some of the programming and services are as follows:

- Monthly storytime for preschool children
- Six weeks of summer reading programming
- Additional summer programs such as pool story times, workshops, bingo days
- After-school LEGO clubs
- After-school tutoring services for children grades 1-4
- Movie Days on school early-out teacher in-service days
- Genealogy searching with historic newspapers, databases and cemetery records.
- Home school material assistance
- Children's book club
- Adult book discussions
- Latest books, audiobooks, magazines, newspapers and movies
- E-books and Audiobooks available for download to electronic devices 24/7 from any device with internet capabilities and a library cardholder number.
- Computers with internet access, office programs, scanning, printing and faxing capabilities for patrons
- Computer classes
- Copy, fax and laminating services

## Camping

**Union Grove State Park** is located just 11 miles south of Beresford off I-29. Twenty-five camping sites are available. The area's unique dark forest amidst a vast open prairie features 120 campsites, 10 horse camps, eight cabins, a 12-person lodge, six miles of multi-use trails, disc golf, playgrounds and picnic areas. Nearby Lake Lakota provides fishing, boating, swimming and picnicking amenities. Newton Hills hosts numerous folk music concerts and educational programs throughout the year. The 1,063-acre site is open year-round. Between October 1 and April 30 each year, bow hunting is allowed in the park. 

## Parks

The City of Beresford boasts an impressive number of parks and playgrounds with a variety of amenities.

Bulow Park is located in the heart of the city and features several playground areas, swimming pool, tennis and basketball courts, horseshoe pits, several picnic shelters, a band shell as well as many other areas for your enjoyment.

Another City Park is located on North Second Street directly north of the railroad tracks. This smaller park has a picnic shelter and playground equipment.





## Bulow House

The title and the land on which the current Bulow House is located was issued in December 1898 to William J. Bulow. The house was built shortly thereafter.

Mr. Bulow was born on January 13, 1869, in Moscow, Ohio. He graduated from the University of Michigan law school in 1893. He moved to Sioux Falls in 1895, and joined the Joe Kirby office. Mr. Bulow came to Beresford by horse and buggy in 1898, where he set up his own law office and helped develop the town. He married the daughter of J.W. Reedy, a prominent figure in Beresford's early history.

Mr. Bulow was Beresford's city attorney from 1902 to 1927, excluding the years of 1912-1917 when he served as Beresford's mayor. Receiving the highest vote ever by a Democratic candidate for governor at that time, Bulow served as South Dakota's first Democratic



Governor. He also served as a U.S. Senator from 1931-1943. He continued to reside in Washington, D.C., until his death in 1960.

Bulow kept a legal residence in Beresford throughout his entire life, and voted by absentee ballot. Bulow's Beresford residence was declared a National Historic Site in 1989.

The Historic Bulow House opened as a bed and breakfast and as a community/small group facility on May 15, 2009. The house is located 207 W. Hemlock. For more information, call 763-5954.

## Law Enforcement

The Beresford Police Department provides services to the residents of Beresford 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. A chief of police, as well as three full-time officers, staff the department. The city also has several part-time officers to make sure all shifts are covered.

Officers are involved in on-going training programs designed to better equip them to handle situations related to law enforcement with the highest degree of proficiency. Equipment is kept current to meet the needs of the community.

## Fire Department

Beresford Fire and Rescue consists of 40 members, all volunteers and all certified firefighters. The chief officers are the fire chief and two assistant chiefs. They are supported by 37 firefighters including nine captains and five lieutenants. The department has five certified instructors for in-house training and are active with the South Dakota Firefighters Association and the South Dakota division of fire safety training.

The department operates from a central fire station with nine drive-out bays. The building has training and meeting facilities for 100 persons with a complete kitchen.

The department maintains two tankers; two pumpers, one with a 102-foot aerial; two grass rigs; rescue unit; hazardous materials trailer, and several transport vehicles.

Major items other than standard gear and equipment are two complete Jaws of Life rescue tools and one portable tool. SCBA air tank refill station. Dispatch area for large-scale emergencies and back-up power.



## Ambulance

The Beresford ambulance consists of volunteers who donate their time to helping others in need. The ambulance staff consists of over 21 EMTs, nine RNs, one paramedic and 10 drivers who respond to accidents, emergencies and other medical-related emergencies.

The Beresford Ambulance responds to all calls — whether within city limits or along the interstate.

## Senior Events Center

The Beresford Senior Citizens organization was established in 1976, and became an updated entity in 2008. At that time, the Seniors relocated to a remodeled building in the southwest part of the city near the Bridges Golf Course.

The current membership is 50. With a combination of their own fund-raisers, building rentals and generous subsidies from the city, United Fund and others, the center continues to serve the community.

Members enjoy the fellowship of playing cards and other games twice a week, with members taking turns serving snacks and coffee. Other activities include monthly potluck dinners, occasional day trips to sightsee or take in a theater play, and Bingo parties.

The Events Center continues to offer a place for the Federal Senior Nutrition Program, which serves meals five days per week. Participation includes serving from 12 to 20 meals on-site and home delivery



(Meals On Wheels) of about 12 to 15 meals a day. The Senior Events Center provides the necessary kitchen and serving site required by the program. Volunteers assist paid personnel in this work. Volunteers also carry the Meals-On-Wheels to shut-ins who need them.

The Senior Events Center is continually seeking new members. This meeting place is providing a healthy and interesting place for many in the community.

## ROCS Transit

The public transportation service has been in Beresford since 1988 and is sponsored by the Rural Office of Community Services (ROCS). The funds for this bus service are provided by the city of Beresford, Union County Commissioners, Lincoln County Commissioners, Beresford United Fund, various community organizations and by a grant from the State Department of Transportation.

The ROCS main office is located in Lake Andes with the Beresford office/three-stall bus barn located at 1108 W. Spruce in Beresford. The fleet includes an 18-passenger bus with a wheelchair lift, a wheelchair van and a seven-passenger regular van. Often more than one vehicle is needed at the same time and sub-drivers are available on short notice.

Any age can use the transit service which operates Monday through Friday. The charge for a ride out of town is \$20 and in town is \$5.

Clients use the appropriate vehicle for medical appointments to Sioux Falls, "shop-till-you-drop" trips, and social events. Children may also use the transit bus for special outings such as a fun day to the circus,

The transit service works on a first-come, first-serve basis but the drivers will work to meet your needs.

Each and every day of the year Community Education activities are underway. Activities include adult technology classes geared toward improving job skills, activities for children in kindergarten through eighth grade such as recreational soccer, flag football and basketball, arts programs, and much, much more.

A key component of Beresford Community Education is Watchpuppy Depot, the state’s first fully-integrated preschool that brings together 3- to 5-year-old students from Head Start, Special Needs Preschool, and a fee-based preschool in one classroom. Teachers trained in early childhood education and special education work together to create an enriching, exciting, life-enhancing curriculum that prepares children — and families — for their grade school years and beyond.

Watchpuppy Depot has, in many ways, become a model for preschool programming throughout the state.

## Ordinances

The City of Beresford ordinances are enforced to protect your property, maintain our community's environment and to enhance the quality of life in our community. The following information on ordinances is a brief description; contact City Hall, 763-2008, for additional information.

**IMPROPERLY-LICENSED VEHICLES** – Automotive vehicles or trailers of any kind without current license plates shall not be parked or stored on any residentially-zoned property other than in a completely enclosed building.

**CURFEW FOR MINORS** – It shall be unlawful for any minor under the ages of 15 years to be on or present upon any street, avenues, alleys, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds or places of amusement or entertainment, or places of business or vacant lots in the city before 6 a.m. or after 10 p.m. on any days of the week, unless such minor is accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult having the care or custody of such minor.

It shall be unlawful for any minor over the age of 14 years and under the age of 18 years to be on or present upon any streets, avenues, alleys, parks, playgrounds or other public grounds or places of business or vacant lots in the city on the days and at the times as follows:

- (1) Monday through Thursday, both inclusive, before 6 a.m. or after 11 p.m.;
- (2) Friday, before 6 a.m.;
- (3) Saturday, between the hours of 12:30 a.m. and 6 a.m.;
- (4) Sunday, between the hours of 12:30 a.m. and 6 a.m. or after 11 p.m. unless such minor is accompanied by his parents, guardian or other adult person having the care or custody of such minor.

**VEGETATION/GRASS** – All weeds, unhealthy vegetation and other noxious matters and all grasses over 8 inches in height may be declared a nuisance.

**WATERING RESTRICTIONS** – The City shall have the right to declare a water emergency and temporarily restrict the use of water from the City Water Distribution System for certain purposes. During said emergencies, it shall be unlawful for any person to utilize water from the City Water Distribution System for purposes of watering lawns or gardens between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. Newly-planted grass or sod shall be exempt from this prohibition. Upon declaration of an emergency by the City Water Superintendent and/or City Administrator, the City shall publish the watering restriction on Beresford Cablevision and any other media as needed.

**SNOW/ICE REMOVAL** – The owner of any lot or parcel of land in the City abutting upon any sidewalk shall, within 12 hours after any snow upon such sidewalk, or within 12 hours after snow or ice has, from any cause collected upon such sidewalk, remove the same from so much of the sidewalk as adjoins his premises.

**ANIMALS** – All dogs kept, harbored or maintained in the City of Beresford shall be licensed and registered if over 6 months of age on or before Jan. 31 of each year or as such animals become 6 months of age if subsequent thereto.

It is unlawful to allow any animal owned, controlled or harbored by any person to run at-large on the streets, alleys or property of any other person within the City limits. Any person having an animal within the City limits may allow it to roam upon their property. It shall be unlawful for any person to allow an animal off the premises without the animal being held on a leash.

The owner or custodian of an animal shall not allow the animal to create a disturbance by making loud noises (barking).

No owner, keeper, caretaker or attendant of a dog or cat shall allow that animal to defecate on public or private property other than their own. If such dog or cat does defecate upon such public or private property, the owner, keeper, caretaker or attendant must immediately clean the fecal material from such property.

### **TRANSPORTING RUBBISH AND WASTE TO THE CITY**


**RUBBLE SITE** – Any permitted material transported to the restricted use facility shall be delivered in a covered or tarped vehicle, or bagged in biodegradable bags designated for yard waste. If in plastic bags, the bags must be emptied and removed from the site by the person delivering the material. Trees, branches, untreated lumber, and construction debris delivered to the facility shall be delivered in a covered or tarped vehicle, or be secured as not to allow material to fall or be blown off the vehicle while in transit.




